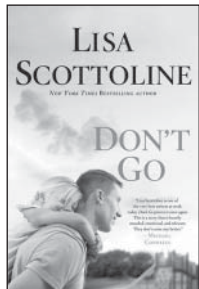

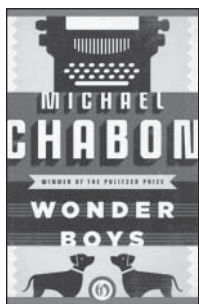
### Mystery Lovers Book Club

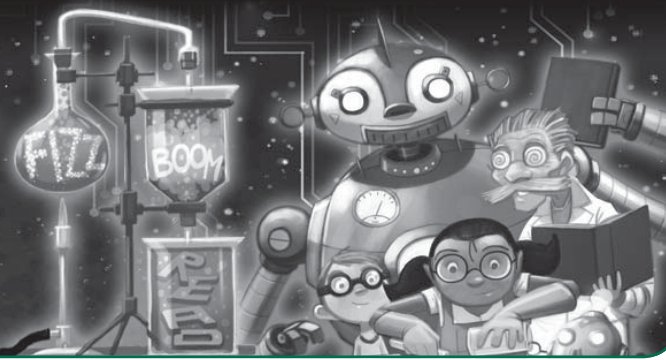
