



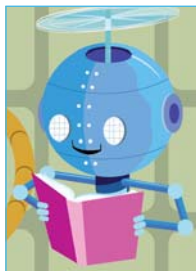
Summer Reading Incentive Program

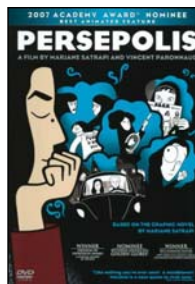

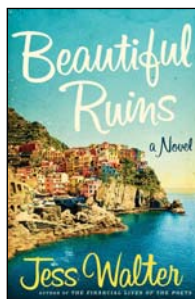
