Shelter: A Mickey Bolitar Novel (YA COB)

After tragic events tear Mickey Bolitar away from his parents, he is forced to live with his estranged Uncle Myron and switch high schools, where he finds both friends and enemies, but when his new girlfriend, Ashley, vanishes, he follows her trail into a seedy underworld that reveals she is not what she seems to be.

Last Shot: A Final Four Mystery (YA FEI, YA CD FEI)by John Feinstein (1st in series)

After winning a basketball reporting contest, eighth graders Stevie and Susan Carol are sent to cover the Final Four tournament, where they discover a talented basketball player is being blackmailed into throwing the final game.

Death Cloud (YA LAN She V1)by Andy Lane (1st in series)

In 1868, with his army officer father posted to India, and his mother mysteriously “unwell,” fourteen-year-old Sherlock Holmes is sent to stay with his eccentric uncle and aunt in their vast house in Hampshire, where he uncovers his first murder and diabolical villain.

A Spy in the House (YA LEE)by Y.S. Lee (1st in series)

Rescued from the gallows in 1850s London, young orphan and thief Mary Quinn is offered a place at Miss Scrimshaw’s Academy for Girls where she is trained to be part of an all-female investigative unit called The Agency and, at age seventeen, she infiltrates a rich merchant’s home in hopes of tracing his missing cargo ships.

Kiki Strike: Inside the Shadow City (YA MIL)by Kirsten Miller (1st in series)

Life becomes more interesting for Ananka Fishbein when, at the age of twelve, she discovers an underground room in the park across from her New York City apartment and meets a mysterious girl called Kiki Strike who claims that she, too, wants to explore the subterranean world.

The Ruby in the Smoke (YA PUL, YA CD PUL)by Philip Pullman (1st in series)

In nineteenth-century London, sixteen-year-old Sally, a recent orphan, becomes involved in a deadly search for a mysterious ruby.

Independence Hall (YA SMI Iq V1)by Roland Smith (1st in series)

Thirteen-year-old Q and fifteen-year-old Angela expect their lives to become complicated when his father and her mother, wildly popular magicians, marry, but not that they will face spies and terrorists in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The Case of the Missing Marquess: An Enola Holmes mystery (YA SPR)by Nancy Springer (1st in series)

Enola Holmes, much younger sister of detective Sherlock Holmes, must travel to London in disguise to unravel the disappearance of her missing mother.
