VISITORS


The Library served more than **333.945 visitors**.

SUPPORTING COMMUNITY



- Reached out to 6,649 attendees at 26 events on campus, at local parks, and at community events.
- Library staff and volunteers brought books to over 9,220 children in daycares and preschools through 926 Project Smyles visits.
- 85 middle and high school teens gave back 1,664 hours through APL-Y Summer volunteering.
- 4,033 people participated in the Summer and Winter Reading Challenges, and the year round 12 to Try Challenge for Adults.





- **7,639 visitors** checked out 25,587 items at 240 events and regular stops on the **Bookmobile**.
- Library staff and volunteers made
 769 deliveries of books and materials to homebound customers and centers through
 Home Delivery.

OUR PROJECTS

After much community engagement, the Library launched it's new 2025-2030 strategic plan focusing on three key areas — Connecting Ames, Serving Ames, and A Place for Ames.

Highlights from this past year include:



Iowa Center for the Book (Connecting Ames)

Hosted 31 events celebrating lowa's literary heritage as the Library of Congress' Center for the Book affiliate.

Digital Equity grant (Serving Ames)

Collaborated with libraries around Story County to connect residents to quality wifi and technology resources through a community betterment grant from Story County Community Foundation.

New carpet (A Place for Ames)

Updated the look, feel, and cleanliness of our spaces with new carpet! The carpet had seen nearly 4 million visitors and, despite diligent cleaning and maintenance, needed a refresh.
