#### **LEGO – A short history**

The name 'LEGO' is an abbreviation of two Danish words "leg godt" that mean "play well."

The LEGO group was founded in 1932 by Ole Kirk Kristiansen. LEGO has been named

"Toy of the Century" twice! The LEGO brick is LEGO's most popular product, and the LEGO

Group estimates that it has produced 400 billion blocks in the last 50 years. LEGO bricks

are also used in engineering and technical fields to do real design and science.
