## **HathiTrust**

"HathiTrust is a partnership of academic and research institutions, offering a collection of millions of titles digitized from libraries around the world." Pre-1926 materials are copyright-free and are available in full-text. Some newer content is also freely available. The ISU Library is a member of HathiTrust, so you will be able to access more full-text from ISU Library workstations (using a guest login) than you will otherwise. Some examples of full-text materials include:

<u>Life of Rufus Putnam</u>, with extracts from his journal and an account of the first settlement in Ohio – the first few pages give the family genealogy, followed by information about what life was like in that time. Family originated in New England, but then were among the first settlers in Ohio. [Print version available in Parks Library General Collection – F483 P96]

*Iowa State Gazetteer and Business Directory* (HathiTrust has many from the <u>early 1900's</u>; these years and also the 1889/90 and 1892 editions are available in Parks Library General Collection.)
